Registration and Operations Guidelines for Unmanned Aircraft (UA)/Drones

How to Register

 Register your UA/Drone with the Department of Civil Aviation (Regulatory Section) by downloading the application form at www.dca.gov.bn



 Fill out the registration form and email it to unmanned.aircraft@dca.gov.bn along with the following documents: -

Completed Registration form

Copy ID / Passport Drone Specs

AITI Import Permit Certificate

The Basic Do's and Don'ts

Only operate and fly your UA/Drones during the day. Operating UA/drones during the night-time is prohibited

Do not operate or fly your UA/drones within 5 kilometres of an airport or military base.

Do not operate or fly your UA/drones in restricted areas.

Do not operate or fly your UA/drones at public events without a flying permit.

Do not operate or fly your UA/Drones more than 200 feet above the sea level without flying permit

Any violation of the rules as mentioned above is an offence in accordance with Civil Aviation Order 2006 Part X, General, Offences and Penal Provision, Para 51 (1) the offender shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$50,000 or imprisonments for a term not exceeding 5 years or both.
